Here is some information about each of the families:

Case 1: Mr. and Mrs. W have 8 children and 4 grandchildren within their home. They have found it challenging to manage their bills during this pandemic. Mrs. W started working overnight, but still has trouble making ends meet. This Christmas Mr. and Mrs. W need support with catching up on past due bills, winter clothing, household items and Christmas toys for children.

Case 2: Ms. D is a mother of seven children. She has been struggling to pay her rent. Ms. D's family has encountered both bed bugs and mice. There is also a hole in the family's bathroom ceiling causing water to leak through. Her property management has promised to address the issues but has yet to follow through. Rats and mice are frequently found in the home eating what food they do have. Making matters worse, this summer their air conditioning unit was stolen. They have had many items from their vehicle stolen as well. The copper water pipes were stolen from the home causing water issues in the basement. Help for this family would mean a lot this Christmas.
